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TAYLOR FFA Member Success Points System

Points assist in determining chapter-level awards & recognition, seniority for trips & events, & evaluation of chapter officers.

If needed, tie-breakers will be determined by the highest points earned in the following categories:

- 1) Chapter Activities
- 2) Community Service
- 3) Fundraiser Participation

Members must be in **good standing** to earn points (verified by Advisor)

Points are determined based on records in AET. Sign-In sheets will be used to update AET. Members are responsible for verifying their own AET records.

CDE/LDE Practices	5 each practice, 25 max per contest area
Competing in Official CDEs/ LDEs	15 each competition
State Leadership Conferences	10 each conference
National FFA Convention	5 total
State FFA Convention	5 total
Serving as an FFA Officer	25 max = 5 for attending STARS, + 5 per month if all duties met (Aug-May)
Community Service	20 each FFA Chapter-wide event
Fundraiser Participation	1 per \$10 raised; 50 max per fundraiser
Exhibiting at Fairs	20 max = 10 for Volusia County Fair, 1 per additional fair/show (student is responsible for logging in AET)
